Frances Itani, C.M., award-winning author and a Member of the Order of Canada, has written 11 books. She grew up in a small village in Quebec, studied with the late W.O. Mitchell, has an M.A. in English Literature, and has travelled and lived in many countries. Her novel *Deafening* has been translated into 17 languages, won a 2004 Commonwealth Prize, was shortlisted for the 2005 IMPAC Dublin International Literary Award, and was chosen for 2006 *CBC Canada Reads* as well as *Combat des Livres*.

Her prize-winning stories have won three CBC Literary Awards, The Ottawa Fiction Award, and the CAA Jubilee Award for Best Collection of Short Stories. She will be discussing and reading excerpts from her latest novel, *Remembering the Bones*, which was shortlisted for the 2008 Commonwealth Prize.
